



Mystic Seaport

For those joining the KSA at Mystic Seaport here is what the chart looks like.

The Seaport is to the left indicated by a red arrow. The channel up the Mystic River is a bit long a windy and you need to pay close attention to the channel markers. The depths can be shallow and sometime rocky if you fall outside the channel.

You enter the channel from the Sound just west of Ram Island and then hug Noank and continue to follow around Sixpenny Island. As you continue NE you will approach a railroad bridge (swing bridge) marked here by a blue arrow. Call the bridge tender on channel 13 to let them know your intention. It may not be open so you may have to wait according to their schedule. Beyond that is the Mystic River Highway Bridge marked by a green arrow which opens 40 minutes after the hour when requested.

Once you have passed through both bridges Mystic seaport is just a short ways ahead to starboard. Call them on Channel 71 for docking assistance.

Boaters and their guests will receive complimentary museum admission. In addition dockage includes free wireless, power, water, and shower facilities.
